### Badge Renewals:

\*\*\* Attendance at both sessions is required to be credentialed in Children's Response.

BACKGROUND SCREENINGS are required for all DR volunteers. All NEW volunteers and any returning volunteers who have not completed a form with us since 2018 need to complete a Background Screening form (*included in your training packet*). Favorable background screenings are valid for three (3) years, expiring when your badge expires.
