1. Write the following letter to the IRS on the church's letterhead. This is only an example. Replace the example information with your church information and fill in the places where you see a line, as indicated. If this example letter does not accurately reflect your current situation, you may make changes.

2. **Mail the letter to the IRS.** Be sure to include documentation that shows you have legally changed the church's name, such as a statement from the SC Secretary of State, or other entity that has recognized your new name. In a few weeks, you should receive a reply from the IRS that shows they have changed your name.
