Job Purpose

As a Missions Catalyst you will spend 10-15 hours per week assisting the Missions Pastor in the core missionary tasks of entry, evangelism, discipleship, leader development, healthy church formation, and partnership. This will include identifying diaspora groups living in Columbia, helping organize mission trip/activities, analyzing demographic data, sharing the Gospel, starting a new bible study, and assisting in various tasks to support our church planters and mission partners. You will receive training on how to do each of these tasks prior to doing the task. A desired outcome of this role is to develop in the Catalyst an understanding of what it means to live on mission and equip others to do the same.

Duties and Purpose

- 35% Mapping diaspora populations in the Columbia area
- 20% Assist in organizing mission trip/engagements
- 20% Pull and analyze demographic data
- 10% Teach someone how to share their faith
- 10% Teach someone how to start and lead a bible study
- 5% Support of church planters and missionary partners

- Have a passion to serve Jesus and show promise toward serving as a leader in the church with preference given toward serving a missions' leader path
- Be an active member of a SCBC church, with recommendation from pastor
- Have clear testimonies of salvation, baptism, and a renewed life

- Meet the skills requirements as outlined by each Team's job description
- The ability to drive to Columbia, SC and other locations
