# III. Paul's Travel Timeline Involving the Churches in Macedonia and Corinth:

- A. Paul's Second Missionary Journey: (Macedonian Churches Acts 17)
  - 1). Church at Phillippi is established, AD 50-51.
  - 2). Church at Thessalonica is established, AD 51.
  - 3). Church at Berea is established, AD 51
  - 4). Church at Corinth is established, AD 51 (Acts 18)
- B. Paul's Third Missionary Journey:
  - 1). Paul writes 1 Corinthians from Ephesus, AD 53-54
  - 2). Paul writes 2 Corinthians from Macedonia, AD 55-56
