I. THE POINT IS THIS! - 2 Corinthians 9:6-15

- A. The Heart of God's Invitation: vv. 6-7
 - 1). Generosity includes, but is not limited to, financial giving
 - 2). Bountiful generosity
 - 3). Cheerful generosity
- B. Discussion #1:
 - 1). In addition to financial gifts, what are some other ways we have given and/or received generosity from people?
 - 2). Why does God focus so much on the "heart" of giving in these verses?
 - 3). How can we discern whether our giving is motivated by a true desire to be generous or by external pressure?
 - 4). What are some personal or societal pressures that can lead people to give reluctantly or under compulsion? How can we overcome these pressures?
 - 5). Have you ever experienced an occasion when giving your time, resources, or talents resulted in blessings that exceeded what you gave? How did that impact your view of generosity?
- C. The Results of Accepting God's Invitation to Give Bountifully and Cheerfully: vv.8-15
 - 1). An abundance of God's grace vv. 8-1
 - 2). Thanksgiving to God v. 12
 - 3). Glorifying God v. 13
 - 4). Praise God for his inexpressible gift v. 14
 - 5). The results of accepting God's invitation to generosity at our moment in time.
